Diana D seconded; Motion passed.</li> <li>Some \$\$ to be recouped through ticket sales/concession</li> <li>Money raised to be returned to PAC and earmarked for further fine arts expenses</li> </ul>	\$3500 approved for Annie the Musical.
Fundraising Update (Marla D)	Dominos "raise the dough"  - easy to order online and PAC gets back \$5 per order placed. Don't have to sell physical tickets/coupons, enter a code online and paid out by Dominos  - ETA, end of Jan or early Feb for pizza, so not over extending fundraising ask over the Holidays  Driftwood and Simon Holt restaurant offering fundraising: Gift cards to be sold in \$25 and \$50 increments. PAC will receive back 20% of total sales. Purchase through munch a lunch.  - Clare Z is the contact person (parent at McGirr)  Purdy's – sales to be completed by Dec 3, done online via Purdy's website.  Pink Shirt Day  - \$15/shirt our cost, plan to charge \$20/shirt, earning \$5 per shirt sold back to PAC  - 2 designs to chose from  - sales close by Jan 15 th for Feb delivery  - Local artist/supplier (MnB custom creations)  Card Project  - Cards done, orders to close in November
